Worker training funds awarded

The Finger Lakes Workforce Innovation in Regional Economic Development has announced \$262,540 in worker training funding to 15 area businesses.

Finger Lakes WIRED plans to award a total of \$700,000 to companies in optics and imaging, biotech and life science, food and agriculture, advanced manufacturers, alternative energy, information technology, engineering, business services and health care.

Last month, WIRED awarded roughly \$145,000 in grants to 14 area businesses to train workers in Monroe, Livingston, Ontario, Wayne and Wyoming counties.
